The Business Voices Future Leaders Week is a simple way for BNI professionals to offer young people ages 15-18 Career Orientation advice within their local community.

For one week in October we are asking Chapters to hold their Meeting in a local school, showcasing the way BNI teams work together in weekly Meetings. After the Meeting, individual Members will remain in the school to talk and answer questions about their chosen professions.

If the chosen school is unable to accommodate a full Chapter Meeting, there are two other options for participating:

1. Volunteering Members hold a Career Orientation morning in the school.
2. If no school is available, the Career Orientation event is held in a local young people's club.

Business Voices is the part of the BNI Foundation which focuses on how BNI Members, Directors, and Chapters can use their time, talent, knowledge, and experience to help children in the communities in which they live and work.



HOW IT WORKS

- Project overview and information distributed by GST and National Offices.
- Chapters sign up to participate on the same day they normally meet.
- BNI Foundation sends your Chapter all the necessary information to successfully participate.
- Chapter reaches out to a local school - wording suggestions provided by BNI Foundation.
- Weekly Chapter Meeting and/or Career Orientation sessions held in the school.
- Chapter reports number of Members and Students in attendance and submits any photos or videos from the day.
